Each level requires them to learn more about horses and their care and to become increasingly accomplished riders. You don't have to own a

Pony Club believes that Safety and the care of the horse – Horse Management – should be primary goals for all riders. Pony Club members participate in team competitions called rallies, which help them learn the importance of cooperation and friendship. There are rallies and Championships every year. Plus every three years, Festival is held: an event that combines Championships and an educational program held at the Kentucky Horse Park.
